



# STAY SAFE ON SITE



## ANIMALS AND LIVESTOCK

Please respect our animals and be aware of the risk of E. coli O157. Contact with animals and their faeces should be avoided. Wash your hands after contact with animals or animal enclosures.



## CHILDREN

Children must be supervised at all times. Please do not allow children to climb trees or to enter the mill pond.



## DISABLED VISITORS

An accessible route is marked on the complimentary map – please ask our team for advice.



## DOGS

Dogs must be kept on short leads - extending leads should be locked at a short length. Please pick up after your pet and keep them at a safe distance from birds and livestock.



## FIRES AND SMOKE

Buildings may contain open fires or stoves. Maintain a safe distance from these at all times and safeguard children and vulnerable adults.



## NO SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited within the Museum site, its fields, decks and arrival courtyard. Visitors may smoke in the car park.



## SLIPS, TRIPS OR FALLS

Surfaces and steps can be uneven, steep or slippery. Be extra careful in wet or cold weather and hold available hand rails. Take care around the mill pond.
